**Dear Sir/Madam!**

The European Standards EN 12195-1 regarding load restraining on road vehicles, EN 12642 regarding securing of cargo on road vehicles ("Code XL"), and EUMOS 40509 regarding load unit rigidity describe important securing and testing procedures for the carrying of transport packages. Consignors, carriers and drivers must be accurately informed about whether the vehicle body and transport packages (load units) are sufficiently stable, resulting in proper load securing, and whether enough securing force is being applied.

As a neutral, non-profit expert organisation, EUMOS has been publishing practice-oriented testing standards (EUMOS 40509, EUMOS 40511) for many years in order to make the procedures about load securing and packaging more transparent and comprehensible – and with a globally increasing popularity and demand.

The EU directive 47/2014/EU about technical roadside inspection cites EUMOS Standards in appendix III as a contribution for further increasing road traffic safety in Europe. For standardised heavy goods transport controls, the EU states should issue legal and administrative regulations before 20th May 2017 and apply them from 20th May 2018.

At the EUMOS symposium 2017, top experts from all over the world will give lectures on the topics "load securing – packaging – load units".
